SAFETY AND SECURITY

At the March Condo Association Meeting, Officer Dana Stroman from the Montgomery Police Department (MPD) gave a presentation on community safety. She recommended the following items to keep your belongings safe:

- Keep your car doors locked at all times.
- Remove any spare keys from the vehicle.
- Remove any valuables from the vehicle.
- Close windows each time you exit the vehicle.
- Register your bicycle (required by law) with MPD.

- Use antitheft devices on your bike as well as your car. To prevent airbag theft, use a steering wheel lock such as The Club.

OUTDOOR SPACES

As the weather improves, many will start to use their decks and patios more frequently, as well as bikes, scooters, etc. For the safety and consideration of all, please remember:

GRILL SAFETY

- Please keep your grill as far away from the wall of your unit as possible.
- If your grill is on, NEVER leave it unattended. If you are using a smoker, always remain with the grill.
- Always have a fire extinguisher within reach of your grill.
- If you are using wood or charcoal as your heating source, make sure your grill is not letting any flammable or ignited materials come in contact with the deck or unit.
- If you are changing the fuel tank on your gas or propane grill, make sure you check the fuel line for any leaks.
- If a fire caused by your grill or smoker damages your deck or unit contact the Kenwood Forest II manager and fire department.

BIKES, SCOOTERS, STROLLERS

 All personal items must be kept on your deck or patio in a neat and organized fashion. These may not be stored below or beside your deck or patio. The appearance of our community matters and everyone doing their part to make it presentable is needed and appreciated.
